

Colored Pencil Painters Guild Rohan Recreation Center Themed Open Exhibit Rules

2018-2020 Exhibit Dates

- Wednesday, September 19, 2018, to Wednesday, January 16, 2019
- Wednesday, January 16, 2019, to Wednesday, May 15, 2019
- Wednesday, May 15, 2019, to Wednesday, September 18, 2019
- Wednesday, September 18, 2019, to Wednesday, January 15, 2020

Paintings will be accepted between **9:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.** on the above dates. No late entries will be accepted. Registration forms are on the website or contact **Victoria Peterson or Cheryl Gates** for additional information. Registration forms must be received seven (7) days prior to the start of the exhibit.

Media Standards

All work must be done in 100% colored pencil. (See “What is Colored Pencil?” on our website: www.pencilpainters.com.)

Condition of Submitted Artwork

Paintings must be clean and properly framed, with wire for hanging, and bumpers placed on the back lower corners to protect the walls. No saw-tooth hooks may be used. Tracking sheets must be used (available on the CPPG website). Art display cards (provided by CPPG at registration OR available on the CPPG website) must be used, and placed in the lower left corner of the front; price can be shown if the painting is for sale.

Entry Rules

Placement of paintings will be at the discretion of the Hanging Committee. All entries must meet Media Standards (described above). Only original artwork no older than 12 years will be accepted. If any painting is found to be not an original, it will be removed from the exhibit. Framed entries must not exceed 42” in either direction. There may only be one entry per person per exhibit. Art of political, religious, and/or nudity subjects will NOT be accepted, due to local governmental policy. Once a painting has been included in the CPPG Rohan Recreation Center Themed Open Exhibit, it cannot be resubmitted for the same exhibit at a later date.

Advanced registration is required, but there is no entry fee. No awards will be presented. Only paid-up CPPG members in good standing are eligible to exhibit at Rohan Recreation Center on the above dates. Paintings must be picked up by the artist (or his/her designee) at the end of the exhibit period. Artwork must remain in the exhibit until the end date unless special notification has been given in writing to the Exhibit Chair. A Recreation Department Disclaimer (included in Registration Form) must be completed by the artist and turned in when registering.

Sales of Paintings

All sales are between the artist and buyer; no “commission” payment to the CPPG is required. If the buyer cannot wait until the exhibit end date to take possession of the painting, please inform the Exhibit Chair that you will be removing the painting for this purpose, and sign a form to this effect.
