

**The following are the guidelines for the upcoming  
Miniature Show sponsored by the CPPG:  
May 18, 2019**

- All artwork, as always, is to be done in 100% colored pencil.
- All artwork is to be framed in 8" x 8" frames. Frames are sold at Michaels in packets of 4. The name on the frame is "Studio Deco", Frame/Cadre/Marco 143439 89536-2018-04. The price for a packet of 4 runs around \$18.00. No other frames will be accepted for this exhibit.
- All artwork within the frame is to be 25 square inches or smaller. For example (5" x 5" = 25 inches), (6" x 4" = 24 inches) , (7" x 3" = 21" inches), (3" x 3" = 9 inches). These are just a number of choices for your artwork.
- All artwork is to be mounted on a white background, OR with a white mat cut to fit the artwork. No need to go out and order expensive mats as the mats that come with the frames are a heavyweight paper such as cardstock cut to 5" x 5" and the mat has no bevel. You may cut your own mats for this show to fit your artwork as long it is neatly done on heavyweight white paper.
- The rules for The Miniature Society of America are that your subject cannot be more than 1/6 the original size. i.e. a 3" apple cannot be presented more than 1/2" in size. We are relaxing the rules slightly. Instead of 1/6th the size of an original, we are suggesting at least 1/3 the size of an original. That would make that 3" apple a 1" on your artwork.
- We would like to encourage our show participants to pick a subject that is challenging and has more detail. Set the bar higher!
- All subjects, portrait, landscape, still life, abstract, etc. will be eligible. No political or religious themes will be accepted.
