

## 2024 Holiday Cards -- Barbara Perron

You may print the card on Bristol paper or card stock. The Holiday card measures a half of sheet of 11 x8 1/2 card stock Using prismacolor pencils for the

Using prismacolor pencils for the Holiday card

930 magenta

924 crimson red

1005 limepeel

908 dark green

1084 ginger root

946 dark brown

915 lemon yellow

902 ultimate marine blue

Using 903 magenta, and 924 crimson red for the leaf of the poinsettia.

Apply a light coat of magenta over all of the leaves then using the Crimson red go over the magenta with another coat continue using magenta and red to get a dark red leaf. Using 915 lemon, yellow for the center of the poinsettia.

For the holly leaf. use 1005 lime peel and 908 dark green applying the lime peel first, and then the dark green over the lime peel.

For the pinecones use 1084 ginger root. Apply a medium layer over the pinecone then using 946 dark brown, make small "u" shapes over the whole pinecone, then go over the pinecone with the dark brown.

For the Evergreens use the dark brown for the branch, which are the lines coming out of the poinsettia using 915 lemon yellow. Make small strokes, coming from the branch to make the pine needles then using 902 ultimate marine blue go over the yellow strokes of the pine needle. You will see it will turn green to fill in more needles, you can continue using the yellow and blue together. You can also use dark green. For the holly berries, use the brown for the branch and crimson red for the berries.

For the flame of the candle, use dark brown for the wick. Go around the outside of the flame using lemon yellow lightly, then the crimson red over the yellow to make a soft orange for the flame.

For the candle we used 924 crimson red going over the whole candle being sure to have your light source coming from the left so the right side of the candle should be darker to make the right side look darker. Using 908 dark green apply a light coat then using the crimson red, go back and forth with the dark green to make the right side of the candle darker.

Please bring your holiday cards to the November meeting. Make a few if you can. We distribute them to area nursing homes and hospitals. You may also bring your own designed holiday cards. We would like as many card as we can get, for we have many nursing facilities in our area.
