

Colored Pencil Painters Guild Fenney Recreation Center Exhibit Rules

2020-2021 Exhibit Dates

Thursday, January 16, 2020, to Thursday, May 14, 2020
Thursday, May 14, 2020, to Thursday, September 17, 2020
Thursday, September 17, 2020, to Thursday, January 14, 2021

Paintings will be accepted between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the above dates. No late entries will be accepted. Registration forms are on the website or contact **Mary Tougas or Jeanne Rogers** for additional information. Registration forms must be received seven (7) days prior to the start of the display.

Media Standards

All work must be done in 100% colored pencil. (See “What is Colored Pencil?” on our website: www.pencilpainters.com.)

Condition of Submitted Artwork

Paintings must be clean and properly framed, with wire for hanging, and bumpers placed on the back lower corners to protect the walls. No saw-tooth hooks may be used. Tracking sheets must be used (available on the CPPG website). Art display cards (provided by CPPG at registration OR available on the CPPG website) must be used, and placed in the lower left corner of the front; price can be shown if the painting is for sale.

Entry Rules

Placement of paintings will be at the discretion of the Hanging Committee. All entries must meet Media Standards (described above). Because this exhibit displays the work of students in a colored pencil class, the requirement that work be original is suspended for the Spotlight Display. Framed entries must not exceed 42” in either direction. There may only be one entry per person per display. Art of political, religious, and/or nudity subjects will NOT be accepted, due to local governmental policy. Once a painting has been included in the CPPG Fenney Recreation Center Exhibit, it cannot be resubmitted for the same display at a later date.

Advanced registration is required, but there is no entry fee. No awards will be presented. Only paid-up CPPG members in good standing are eligible to display at Fenney Recreation Center on the above dates. Paintings must be picked up by the artist (or his/her designee) at the end of the display period. Artwork must remain in the display until the end date unless special notification has been given in writing to the Display Chair. A Recreation Department Disclaimer (included in Registration Form) must be completed by the artist and turned in when registering.

Sales of Paintings

All sales are between the artist and buyer; no “commission” payment to the CPPG is required. If the buyer cannot wait until the display end date to take possession of the painting, please inform the Display Chair that you will be removing the painting for this purpose, and sign a form to this effect.

All sales must take place outside of the Rec Center!
