

FRAMING FOR SHOWS

The pictures below are intended to help you understand the way to prepare your artwork for our judged shows. Your artwork represents hours of intense labor and perhaps years of dedicated learning. Proper framing and mounting will ensure your presentation will not fall during the month(s) it is on display.

INCORRECT



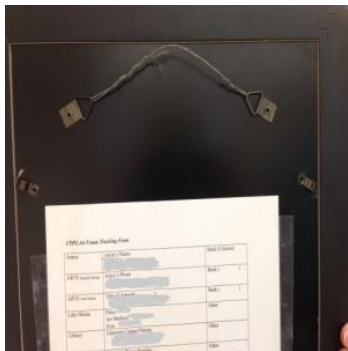
Remember that the frame holds the picture.

The wire, then, must be attached to the frame not to the backing.

Wires should be secured to the frame with screws and appropriate hardware. Screw-eyes are not recommended.

Picture wire should be used.

CORRECT



Tracking sheets must be completely and legibly filled out on all entries and attached to the back.

Minimum and maximum picture to be accepted- minimum 8" , maximum 42" on either side.

All pictures must be framed.



Bumper guards should be placed in lower left and right corners
