Exhibit Rules

1. The Colored Pencil Painters Guild Jubilee is a fine art show only. No religious themes, political themes, or nudes are allowed due to local government rules.
2. Acceptable art work for easels, table tops, and wall displays
 - a. **Must be 100% colored pencil**, which includes watercolor pencil and colored pencil crayon; non-colored pencil art work will be allowed only in browse boxes and cards.
 - b. **Must be Original**. That is, paintings must be of your creation or from photos that you took or had permission from the photographer to paint. Less than 5 Years old
3. Paintings must be clean and properly matted or framed. Prints and cards from your work are acceptable for display. Prints for sale or for display should be matted and in a clear bag. Cards for sale or display should be in a clear bag.
4. The artist must be a paid-up member in good standing in order to register for the Exhibit. Villages ID must be presented at time of registration.
5. The Exhibit Chairs have the right to deny any painting that do not follow these rules. Prior to the start of the Exhibit, event Chairs will conduct a walk-through and will ask you to take down any paintings that don't comply with the regulations.

Space Cost and Table Set-up

1. Each artist-applicant may select to have up to two (2) 6-foot tables/spaces. The registration fee is as follows:
 - a. One 6-foot table/space \$10.00
 - b. Two 6-foot table/space \$20.00
2. When registering, artist need to take into account their display plan, floor easels, browse boxes, card display racks, etc.
3. No Large wall displays can be used, unless the artist can register for table/spaces along a wall.
4. No display can block anyone else's view...front, back, sideways, etc.
5. Tables must be covered with a **Black or White cloth** that will conceal any boxes or other materials stored under the table. Artists must provide their own tablecloths.
6. Browse boxes must be professional type: no cardboard or plastic totes will be allowed.
7. According to Recreation Department Rules, aisles cannot be blocked. Nothing may be placed in front of the tables, or against the ways or protrude outside of you designated space.
8. Artist retain all proceeds from their sale. There is no commission paid to CPPG.
9. Breakdown starts at 3:00 P.M. and not before.
