

COLORED PENCIL PAINTER'S GUILD
"Exploring Colored Pencil Exhibit"
Laurel Manor Exhibit Rules

Paintings will be accepted between 8:30 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. on the designated dates. No late entries will be accepted. Registration forms and additional information will be available on the CPPG website (www.pencilpainters.com). Entry forms must be received seven (7) days prior to the start of the exhibit. Chairperson for these exhibits is Pat Buckert.

Dates of exhibits:

The walls at Laurel Manor are being shared with other groups, so we have only one opportunity each year to hang our artwork. The dates of exhibit and the pick-up date will be announced at monthly meetings and on the CPPG website.

Medium:

As with the other CPPG exhibits, all paintings must be done in colored pencil and may be dissolved with an alcohol, or in the case of W/C pencils, with water. For this exhibit at Laurel Manor, additional medium may be used BUT paintings must be at least 70% colored pencil. On the ID card, please state other media used on your CP paintings.

Condition of Submitted Artwork:

Paintings must be clean and properly framed, under glass, with wire and bumpers on the lower corners to protect the walls. NO SAW-TOOTH hooks may be used. Tracking sheets and Art display cards (provided by CPPG) must be used. These will be made available at sign-in or on the CPPG website. No sale prices will be shown on cards.

Entry:

Placement of paintings will be at the discretion of the Hanging Committee. This is NOT a judged show it is for display only. For this showing at Laurel Manor, you do not have to use original artwork. You can exhibit any of your lovely art whether it has been shown before, has been done in a class, from a workbook or workshop. This will give you the opportunity to show any of your CP artwork. Acceptance of artwork will be on a first-come basis. Framed entries must not exceed 42" in either direction. There may be **two** entries per person for this exhibit. Art of political, religious and/or nudity subjects will NOT be accepted, due to local governmental policy. Once a painting has been included in the Laurel Manor exhibit, it may be submitted for another exhibit at a later date, but you must follow that exhibit's rules and guidelines.

Advanced registration will be required, and there is no fee. No awards will be presented.

Paintings must be picked up by the artist (or his/her designee) at the end of the exhibit period. Any painting not claimed by either person will be donated to charity. Artwork must remain in the exhibit until the date specified on entry form, unless special notification has been given in writing to the exhibit chairperson.

Sale of Paintings:

All sales can be done privately by including your telephone number on your display card: no "commission" payment to CPPG required. If the buyer cannot wait until the exhibit end date to take possession of the painting, please inform the chairperson that you will be removing the painting for this purpose, and sign a form to this effect.
